#### THE BUREAU OF RECLAMATION ISSUES A NOTICE OF MOTION TO AMEND THE ANGLE DECREE FOR THE ORLAND PROJECT (Orland, California)

#### Background:

The United States intends to file a motion in January, 2008, with the United States District Court for the Eastern Division of California, Sacramento Division, to amend the Angle Decree. The Decree, entered by the Court on January 13, 1930, adjudicated the water rights of the United States and individual landowners to the surface flows of Stony Creek and its tributaries. The United States owns, and the Orland Unit Water Users' Association operates, the Orland Project which supplies water from Stony Creek and its tributaries for irrigation of lands in the vicinity of the City of Orland.

#### Description of the Motion:

The motion will seek to amend the place of use of water served by the Orland Project to conform the authorized place of use of project lands with current irrigation practices. Approximately 1,633 acres of land served by the Orland Project would be added to the Orland Project place of use. However, the total number of irrigated acres that may be irrigated in one year would not exceed the current limitation of 21,000 acres. There would be no increases in acreage actually irrigated in any given year. Similarly, there would be no increase in the quantity of Orland Project water actually put to beneficial use in any given year.

#### Opportunity for Objection:

The Court soon will be issuing notice regarding the above described motion. Any party to the Angle Decree desiring to object will be given an opportunity by the Court to file an objection. Additionally, any person not a party to the Angle Decree desiring to object will be given an opportunity by the Court to file a petition to intervene.
